

The Council

The Council is the supreme policy making body. It meets three times a year in different locations within the Central Land Council area. Meetings are open to all Aboriginal people in the Central Land Council area, but only Council members may vote or hold office.

Communities within the Central Land Council area nominate a member (or members) to the Council. The list of communities and allocation of representatives are subject to review by the Council and approval by the Minister.

In 2005-2006 there were 89 Central Land Council members representing 74 communities.
