- consultations and land assessment for an agistment proposal on Pmere Nyente ALT
- establishment of photo points and ongoing inspection to monitor the recovery of a severely degraded and unregulated portion of the Pmere Nyente ALT in the North West Simpson Desert known as 'Todd River Downs' following destocking and aerial culling of feral cattle, horses and camels in May 2005
- exclusion fencing and other works to protect community infrastructure and land condition on Melkngge ALT from impacts of unregulated grazing by cattle from neighbouring Undoolya station
- environmental assessment of station infrastructure placement in the vicinity of sensitive wetland areas of cultural and biological significance on Aboriginal land under commercial grazing licence on Mangkururpa ALT (formerly Tanami Downs pastoral lease);
- traditional owner participation and integration of Indigenous Ecological Knowledge into a bioregional survey in the Davenport region undertaken by NT PWS commencing in the Warrabri ALT area
- a review of the current status and quality of the Yuendumu community water supply and arrangements for maintaining outstation bores in the Yuendumu area
- a review of upgrade options to relieve desperate shortages in supply at the Yuelamu community (Mt. Allan);
- implementation of an Australian Water Fund grant for a pilot project at the remote Alpururalum (Lake Nash) on the Queensland border about water efficiency techniques including greywater reuse
